

## Level 2 Award in Health Promotion Accredited by RSPH

**Who should attend:** This course is appropriate for those wishing to further their learning in the subject area of Health Promotion.

**Pre-requisites:**  
There are no recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. RSPH does, however, recommend that candidates have a level of literacy and numeracy equivalent to *Level 1*.

**Synopsis:**  
The Level 2 Award in Health Promotion is a qualification covering the principles of health promotion. It has been developed to meet the increasing needs of a wide range of individuals to acquire fundamental knowledge and skills in health promotion, so that they are in a position to influence and advise.

The Award provides candidates with an opportunity to work and train within a multi-disciplinary group, exploring and examining basic theory in relation to the concepts, influences and determinants of health.

The qualification route comprises the core unit *The Principles of Health Promotion* and route-specific unit *General Health and Wellbeing*.

### Objectives and learning outcomes .....

#### **Unit HP1 Principles of Health Promotion (Credit Value 2)**

Candidates will be able to:

- Describe factors that influence health
- State the role of effective communication in health promotion
- Explore behaviour change

#### **Unit HP3 Promotion of General Health and Well-Being (Credit value 2)**

Candidates will be able to:

- Outline the scientific basis of health promotion
- Identify opportunities for the practical application of health promotion
- Describe methods of health promotion planning

### Syllabus .....

The course will cover the syllabus for the RSPH Level 2 award in Health Promotion core unit *Principles of Health Promotion*, and the route-specific unit *Promotion of General Health and Well-Being*.

### Assessment

Attainment of the Learning Outcomes will be assessed by coursework consisting of a reflective account of health promotion (for assessment of unit HP1) and a small pilot health promotion project (for the assessment of unit HP3). These will be externally marked.

Candidates will need to satisfy the *Pass* criteria for each assignment to attain the Award.
